Curriculum & Teaching

Inspectors analyze the school's curriculum, teaching methods, and how well students are learning. They observe lessons and review student work to assess the quality of education.



Leadership & Management

They evaluate the school's leadership, management, and how effectively they are running the school. This includes the headteacher's role, staff development, and resource allocation.



Student Wellbeing

3

Inspectors assess the school's approach to student wellbeing, including safety, pastoral care, and the promotion of positive attitudes towards learning.



Parent & Community

4

They examine the school's engagement with parents and the wider community, looking at communication, involvement in school activities, and community partnerships.



Resources & Facilities

5

Inspectors assess the quality and availability of resources, including classrooms, equipment, and technology, as well as the maintenance and safety of the school building.
